## BBA Disaster Relief (DR) News

The Disaster Relief Team was not called out during 2006. Praise the Lord! We attended several local events including the annual Freedom Day celebration at Sunset Cove, the Agri Expo, the SODA expo, and the Durant Christmas parade. We use each opportunity to minister to people in some way and to generate interest in the Disaster Relief ministry.

We trained thirteen people in our October, 2006 training session. Most of them trained for the chain-saw team. I encourage anyone who has a heart for this type of ministry to come to our training session

March 3, 2007. Training will be held at the Durant First Baptist Church beginning at 8:00 a.m. We will make every attempt to be finished by 2:00 p.m.

The team prepared to provide aid to the Durant area when the recent ice storm was first forecast. We made preparations by working in conjunction with the Durant/Bryan County Emergency Management Agency and the American Red Cross. We took our trailer and food supplies to the Fair Grounds and set up inside the Community Center to provide assistance in case of massive power outages. Fortunately our services were not needed in Durant. However, we were called to come to Muskogee January 16<sup>th</sup> to help provide food for hundreds suffering due to power outages. We took our trailer and joined the LeFlore Association and the Muskogee Association trailers at the Fair Grounds in Muskogee. Several chainsaw crews were on site also.

We stayed until Sunday night, January 21<sup>st</sup>. During that time, we prepared two meals a day, lunch and dinner, feeding in the neighborhood of 4,500 to 5,000 meals each day. A serving line was set up on site but most of the meals were sent to remote sites via the American Red Cross. We had a tremendous week being blessed by the Lord with good health and safety, an opportunity to touch the lives of hundreds of people, and many opportunities to provide a witness for Him. The people of Muskogee made us feel that our efforts were really appreciated and the First Baptist Church of Muskogee went out of their way to make our stay comfortable. We stayed in their Christian Life Center where we were provided with air mattresses, showers, and even breakfast for the crew. Praise God for Christian brothers and sisters.

We left our trailer and equipment in Muskogee to be used by teams that came to relieve us. Currently, we are scheduled to go to McAlester Sunday, January 28<sup>th</sup>. If we go, we will be working on the state unit. Again, I urge you to consider becoming a Disaster Relief member by coming to our training session March 3, 2007. Clark Harp, BBA DR Blue Cap

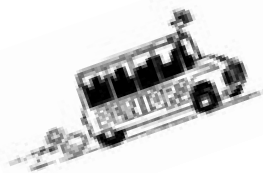
